## **GEOGRAPHICAL AREA:**

To be eligible, nominees must have been born, resided, trained or represented an organisation within the City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council boundaries.

## **PERIOD OF QUALIFICATION:**

1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 – 15<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

## **YOUNG ACHIEVERS (UNDER 18)**

### **Young Male Sportsperson/Young Female Sportsperson –**

These awards recognise and celebrate the accomplishments of young sportspersons in or from Bradford. Nominees will have achieved significant success at county, regional, national or international level or in the context of their own achievements.

**Young Disability Sportsperson –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of young sportspersons in disability sport in or from Bradford. Nominees will have achieved significant success at county, regional, national or international level or in the context of their own achievements.

**Young Club/Team –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of Bradford sports clubs/teams participating in junior (Under 18) competition.

## **SENIOR ACHIEVERS (OVER 18)**

**Sportsman/Sportswoman –** These awards recognise and celebrate the accomplishments of sportsmen and sportswomen in or from Bradford. Nominees will have achieved significant success at county, regional, national or international level or in the context of their own achievements.

**Disability Sportsperson –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of sportsmen and sportswomen in disability sport in or from Bradford. Nominees will have achieved significant success at county, regional, national or international level or in the context of their own achievements.

**Club/Team –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of local sports clubs/teams that have achieved significant success in 2019.

**Club/Team – Amateur –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of Bradford amateur sports clubs/teams that have achieved significant success in 2019.

## **ACTIVE ACHIEVERS**

**Active Lifestyle Award –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of an individual/group in changing their lifestyle to increase their physical activity levels.

**Active Workplace –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of Bradford workplaces in increasing opportunities for their workforce to be physically active.

**Active School –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of Bradford schools in increasing opportunities for their students and staff to be physically active.

**Student Sport – Club/Team –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of student clubs/teams in or from Bradford. Nominees will have achieved significant success at county, regional, national or international level or in the context of their own achievements. This award is open to clubs/teams of all ages who were studying in full or part-time education towards a recognised qualification during the qualifying period.

## **OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION**

**Coach –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of sports coaches in or from Bradford.

**Volunteer –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of sports volunteers in or from Bradford.

**Teacher –** This award recognises and celebrates the accomplishments of teachers in or from Bradford.

**Sporting Highlight –** This award recognises and celebrates iconic sporting moments for Bradford during the qualifying period. This could be a specific event, result, performance or achievement.

**Special Recognition –** This award recognises and celebrates the contribution of an individual or organisation to sport in Bradford during 2019. This could be a long serving volunteer or administrator, an individual achieving at an elite level or an organisation making a real difference.
